**New Member Proposals:**

To insure a smooth and orderly process for the induction of new members into our club, the following procedure as per our by-laws should be followed. After a guest has shown interest in joining BC Sunrise Rotary their name should be submitted to the board by an active member of the club.

The proposal shall be kept confidential.

The board shall ensure the proposal meets all the classification and membership requirements of the club. The board shall then approve or disapprove the submission and notify the proposer.

If the decision of the board is favorable, the prospective member shall be informed of the purposes of Rotary and of the privileges and financial responsibilities of membership, following which the prospective member shall be requested to sign the membership proposal form and to permit his or her name and proposed classification to be published to the club.

If no objection to the proposal is received by the board, that person, upon payment of the admission fee shall be considered to be elected to membership.

Because in the past, proposals have been disapproved, it is important for club members to not assure membership before the process is followed.
