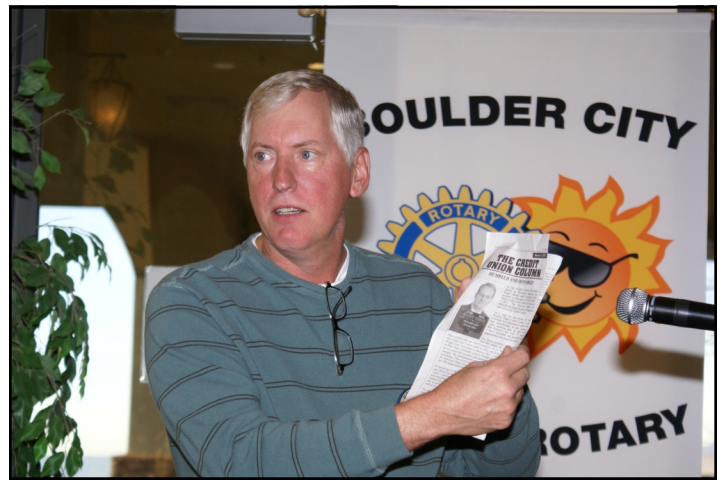
The Eagle has landed
