On Tuesday, August 2, 2011 the Boulder City Police Department and the City of Boulder City will host National Night Out. It will be held at Veterans Memorial Park from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m.

I received the following information from Officer Jen Ford regarding this Event. National Night Out is a nationwide crime and drug prevention event that was created to strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships, generates support for, and participation in, local anticrime programs and send a message to criminals letting them know that neighborhoods are organized and united with their local police to fight back against crime. The event includes an annual tradition called the "Battle of the Badges" softball game between the BC Police and the BC Fire Department. There will be fun activities for kids of all ages which include a rock climbing wall, bounce house, dunk tank and a huge water slide. There will be a giant BBQ and the food is generously donated by Albertsons. SkyDive Las Vegas will be on hand for a demonstration and present the American Flag at the beginning of the softball game. Mercy Air will land one of their helicopters on an adjacent softball field where people can meet the crew and tour the aircraft. The National Park Service will join the fun and bring some of their cool boats and emergency equipment. They will also pass out free life jackets. There will pie and hot dog eating contests. All participants will receive a prize. Officer Daly will give a K9 demonstration and possibly the National Park Service will also. There will be t-shirts for sale including National Night Out, "Battle of the Badges", and other police, fire and National Park Service designs. Bill Tobler will be the emcee and DJ for the evening.
