Getting to know Lee McDonald

Lee organizes the United Blood Services Blood Drive several times a year. Lee has been at the helm of Boulder City's blood drive for six years. He did the first one by default and then the Elks Club decided to quit doing them altogether. United Blood Services needed someone to do the blood drive. Lee agreed to one, then another, and then another and the rest is history. He thought about how much good this service provides; about service above self and that if you are in service to others that you are in service to God. Lee says, "It gives me a sense of doing something for my community and sure enough I really know someone who has had to have several units of blood and may possibly need more, I'm really glad they are still around. We never know who we are helping; we just know it's for the good. That got me calculating... that would be about 2400 lives that were affected. The donors in Boulder City are incredible, they are the best. Blood donors are people who give to some one the will in all probability never meet. That's why I will continue to organize the blood drives."

Lee has been married to his wife Linda for thirty plus years. They have two children and one grandchild. Johanna, his daughter, is an early childhood development director and her eight month old baby girl is named Lilia. Lee is a proud grandfather and is enjoying watching her grow. She currently loves to have quite lengthy conversations with the baby in the mirror when they sit her in front of it. His son is named Fritz and is a 1st lieutenant in the U.S. Army.

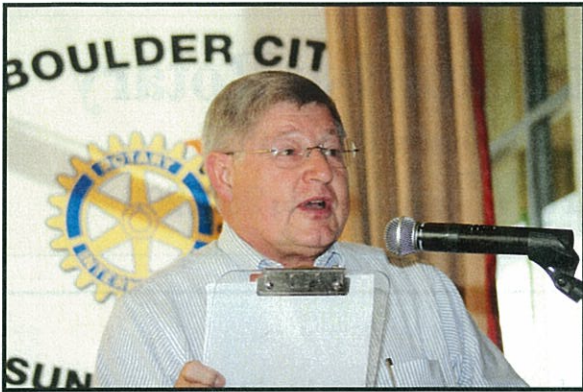
Lee has had his own photography business for twenty-seven years. He has been photographing things in Las Vegas for forty-two years.

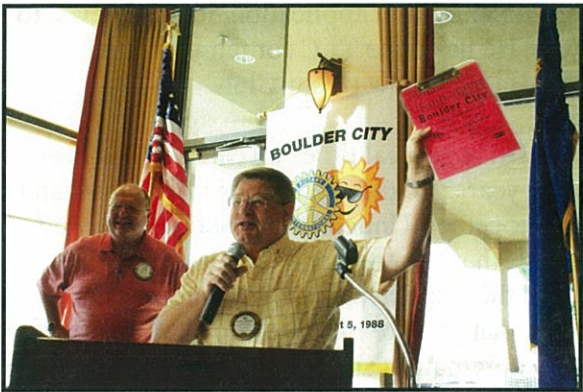
