Art in the Park is a Celebration of Community

This October 1 and 2 marks the 49th anniversary of Art in the Park. This weekend, Wilbur Square, Bicentennial, and North and South Escalante Parks will become one of the largest open-air art galleries in the west. This year's show features more than 260 fine artists, fine craft and traditional craft artisans and Colorado Street once again becomes an open-air food court. Artists travel from all over the west to participate in this time-honored festival. This year, our city's population is estimated to swell to more than 80,000 people as visitors from Henderson and Las Vegas stroll our parks and streets.

When members of the Hospital Auxiliary first produced the art festival in 1962 it was a big idea requiring the talent, commitment and support from our community. That community spirit is still hard at work to produce the largest juried outdoor arts and crafts show in the western United States.

Preparing our town for such a large event requires the combined efforts and coordination of many individuals, civic, business and community groups as well as the City of Boulder City.

Without the continued support of our community, the festival would not be the success it is today. Art in the Park is grateful for the cooperation and support from the City of Boulder City and its various departments. The Police, Fire, Roads, Electrical, Parks and Recreation departments provide infrastructure and order required to produce such an event. Art in the Park is also grateful to numerous business and civic groups, including the Sunrise Rotary Club, Boulder City Chamber of Commerce and Boulder City Hospital Auxiliary. Additionally, Art in the Park is grateful to our corporate supporters and hundreds of volunteers and supporters.
